19th Hole Wilderness Miniature Golf Course – Cascading waterfall, challenging obstacles and lifelike wildlife creatures. Located on State Hwy 70 West (just west of County C), St. Germain (715) 542-4042

Agate Falls – Scenic waterfall is just around the corner from Bond Falls. Go east on Bond Falls Rd, take a left (west) onto MI-28. Agate Falls roadside park will be on the left about 2-3 miles down the road. East of Bruce Crossing, MI.

Bond Falls – Bond Falls is one of those "best kept secret" spots on the Western Upper Peninsula that you want to make sure you do not miss. This beautiful waterfall is located on the middle branch of the Ontonagon River near Paulding. Although it does not get the "press" of more famous U.P. water falls, Bond Falls has a large following of admirers and has even been part of a calendar listing the most scenic natural places in the world! Take US 45 North out of Eagle River to Paulding. Take a right on Bond Falls Road.

Camp Five Museum – Ride the "Lumberjack Special" steam trains to the Camp 5 Complex – departures at 11am, Noon, 1pm, and 2pm. Visit the logging museum, blacksmith shop, nature center, animal barn and petting coral, guided forestry tour by surrey, snack hut and optional hayrack/pontoon boat ride. Camp Five is on the National Register of Historic Places. Located just off State Highways 8 & 32 in Laona at 5480 Connor Farm Rd (715) 674-3414.

Chain Skimmers Water Ski Shows – Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Sundays at 7pm. US Hwy 45 North to Lake Pleasant, Conover.

Dr. Kate Newcomb Museum – Exhibits here preserve the memory of famed country doctor Kate Pelham Newcomb. Dr. Kate inspired the movement to build a hospital in Woodruff, and led the Million Penny brigade with children to collect a million pennies to build it. Located at 923 Second Avenue, Woodruff (715) 356-6896.

Eagle Falls Adventure Golf – Mini-golf featuring 18 holes, 9 holes are ADA accessible, set in fishing theme complete with bait shop, fishing dock hole, fishing cabin and ranger tower. Located at 1040 East Tuss Street (one block south of Trig's Food Store on east side of town), Eagle River (715) 477-0808.

Eagle Lanes – Bowling and great pizza. Located at 534 W. Pine Street (State Hwy 70 East), Eagle River (715) 479-4555

Eagle River Speedway – Races every Tuesday night starting at 7:30pm with Wissota Midwest Modified, Wissota Street Stock, Pure Stocks and Sport Fours. Located at 3919 Cloverland Drive, Eagle River (715) 479-5208.

Elmer's Fun Park – Guided horseback trail rides are offered here along scenic wooded trails. Elmer's also offers three go-cart tracks, and bumper boats. Located at 5735 State Hwy 70 East, St Germain (715) 479-7311.

George W. Brown Jr. Ojibwe Museum & Cultural Center – This museum celebrates the ongoing culture of the Lac du Flambeau band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians. Exhibits include a four-season diorama, a 24-foot dugout canoe, smaller birch-bark canoes, Ojibwe arts and crafts, traditional clothing, a French fur trading post and a world-record sturgeon. Located at 603 Peace Pipe Road, Lac du Flambeau (715) 588-3333.

Hawk's Nest Canoe Outfitters – Canoe, Kayak, Rafting and Tubing Day Trips. Canoe, Camping and Complete Outfitting Overnight Trips. Hawk's Nest Fishing Guides available. Located at 6141 State Hwy 70 East, 8 miles East of St. Germain (715) 479-7944. 9am – 5pm daily, Mid-May thru Mid-September.

Hiking Trails – Vilas County trail maps available at the front desk upon request.

International Snowmobile Hall of Fame – The International Snowmobile Hall of Fame is dedicated to preserving and highlighting the rich and exciting history of snowmobiling at both the recreational and competitive levels. Located at 8481 State Hwy 70 West, St. Germain (715) 542-4488.

Million Dollar Penny – "World's Largest Penny" monument (10 feet in diameter, 18 inches thick and weighing 17,452 pounds) stands in the old Arbor Vitae-Woodruff school grounds. It signifies the determination of 16 students who launched the Million Penny Parade in the early 1950's in an effort to raise 1,200,000 pennies to construct a hospital. Located at Second Avenue & Hemlock Street, Woodruff (715) 356-5266.

Northwoods Children's Museum – The Northwoods Children's Museum enriches lives and strengthens families. It provides hands-on exhibits and programs that make learning fun. As a community resource, the Museum encourages a life-long love of learning. Located at 346 West Division Street, Eagle River (715) 479-4623.

Northwoods Wildlife Center – This center is an operational, non-profit wildlife hospital. Northwoods Wildlife Center offers educational guided tours every half hour. Located at 8683 Blumenstein Road (off State Hwy 70 West), Minocqua (715) 356-7400.

Pictures of Yesteryear – Have your picture taken dressed up in period clothing of days gone by. Located at 112 Wall Street, Eagle River (715) 479-2693.
